

# Home and Home Guidelines for 2010 – 2011 Season

## 1. Improve Communication

- a) More effort in communication specifically focussed on Monday, Wednesday morning leagues and evening curlers.
- a) Improve information on the web site.
- c) Add an information bulletin board on the wall to the right as you enter the club.
- d) Where practical a larger font will be used on all notices.

## 2. Better planning or game scheduling

- a) A total of six games per curling year, three at Lakeshore and three away.
- b) Games are to be scheduled at least two weeks apart.
- c) Friday is the day of choice for scheduling games.
- d) A Home and Home curler registration process will be provided early in the new curling season.
- e) Where the option is available games will consist of 2 draws of 4 ends.

## 3. Funding

- a) Curlers will be given an option regarding cost of participation
  - 1. A 25 dollars annual fee for participation in all games.
  - 2. 5 dollars per game to be paid in advance of scheduled play
- c) To provide additional funding a 50/50 draw will be planned for all home games.

## 4. Volunteers

- a) Participants in this activity are expected to assist in the delivery of the games.
- b.) Volunteers are required for the following positions.
  - 1. **Communication officer – Art Chisholm and Keith Bennett**  
To establish a registration procedure for each event and to plan the location, date and time for the draws  
To serve as a commissionaire for the Home and Home league
  - 2. **Draw master – Dennis Grant will continue in this role**  
To make up the positions for each curler to play from the list on the registration sheet
  - 3. **Refreshments officer**  
To plan and deliver with the help of others the refreshments required.
  - 4. **Treasurer – Bart Herd has volunteered for this position**  
To keep our financial matters in check and plan for the 50/ 50 draw
